**REMINDER- ILLNESS**

We appreciate the help of parents and families in limiting the spread of infectious diseases, particularly during flu season. Please follow these guidelines when deciding whether or not to send your child to school each day.

Children who are ill are excused from attending the program, and should be kept at home. A student who has a fever, vomiting or diarrhea must be kept at home until there has been no fever, vomiting or diarrhea for 24 hours. In addition, a student who is taking a prescribed antibiotic must have been under treatment for 24 hours before returning to the program. If your child develops a fever while at school, or has not been fever free for 24 hours before arriving at school, you will be called to arrange for your child to return home.

Students who arrive at school feeling ill, or who become ill during the school day, will be brought to the nurse for assessment. Minor, non-contagious ailments can be managed at school. If your child is too ill to remain in school, you will be called to arrange for his or her return home.
