DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

Students should feel free to dress comfortably and fashionably, if they wish to do so. However, we do expect everyone to dress appropriately for school. We ask parents to help students cooperate with the following guidelines in order to maintain a school environment that is both comfortable and productive:

- Clothing, jewelry, ornaments, and accessories that may cause a safety hazard will not be allowed.
- Clothing should not be excessively short, too low cut, or revealing. No garments such as tube tops, halter-tops, one shoulder tops, blouses with spaghetti straps, see-through garments, or “muscle shirt” tank tops. Blouse or shoulder straps must be at least one inch wide.
- Undergarments and midriffs must be covered at all times.
- Shorts and skirts should not be shorter than the length of the student’s fingertips when the student’s arms are down at one’s side (3 ½” inseam).
- Shirts or blouses must be long enough to reach the waistline of the pants, shorts, or skirt being worn.
- Clothing should not display scary or inappropriate themes (beer, sex, foul language, etc.)
- Bathing suits for girls should be one piece; for boys trunks only (no Speedos).
- Footwear must be worn at all times. Footwear must not be a safety hazard for the student.

STUDENT CLOTHING LIST

Please bring the following items on the first day, to be left in school:

- 2 Bath Towels
- 1 Swimsuit – One piece only
- 1 Pair sandals, flip flops
- 1 Pair sneakers (required for participation in the gym program)

Please label all clothing with your child’s name.
